Velo Veneto Agreement

Velo Veneto, LLC, (hereinafter referred to as Velo Veneto or The Camp), requires that all persons participating in the cycling camp (The Camp) conducted by Velo Veneto sign this Responsibility Agreement and Release as a condition of their attendance and participation in the The Camp and its activities, including races and training rides. By signing this Responsibility Agreement and Release, you acknowledge and agree that, in consideration of Velo Veneto's provision of The Camp services and accommodations to you:

1. While employees or agents of Velo Veneto may provide you with geographic directions during bicycle rides or races, they do not make, and each of them and Velo Veneto expressly disclaim, any representations or warranties with respect to the condition or safety of the roads on which you will ride or race. You are responsible for observing such road conditions and determining whether you are able to ride or race your bicycle safely in light of such conditions. *In connection with the foregoing, please take notice that certain of the rides and races during The Camp involve ascending and descending long, twisting mountain roads with hairpin turns and imperfect road surfaces. You are solely responsible for determining whether you are physically fit to attempt ascending such roads without endangering your health. You are also solely responsible for determining whether you have the requisite bicycling skills, and whether the bicycle you are operating is mechanically fit, for it to be safe for you to attempt descending such roads. No employee or agent of Velo Veneto may be delegated, or is authorized to accept, any of the responsibility that you have in connection with making such determinations.*
2. You are responsible for the maintenance and safe condition and operation of your bicycles and related equipment while attending The Camp.
3. You own both a helmet meeting Snell or ANSI standards, and protective glasses, and will wear such equipment while engaging in bicycling activities during your stay at The Camp.
4. You possess sufficient bicycling experience and bicycle handling skills to participate safely in the bicycling programs of The Camp.
5. Neither Velo Veneto nor any of its employees or agents will provide you with any instructions on the safe operation of your bicycle in connection with any bicycle ride or race in which you may participate in during The Camp and none of them is under any duty to provide you with such instruction.
6. You are responsible for providing your own insurance while attending the Velo Veneto camp, and for ensuring that such insurance covers your activities during The Camp and is effective outside the United States of America, or your country of residence and citizenship. You are also aware and accept that medical services and facilities may not be readily accessible or of the standard to which you are accustomed.
7. Velo Veneto may make substitutions for services and accommodations where necessary or appropriate. Velo Veneto accepts no responsibility for weather, acts of war or terrorism, strikes, or other events beyond its reasonable control. You voluntarily accept these and other risks inherent in the nature of The Camp.
8. If your behavior is deemed by Velo Veneto to be offensive or dangerous to others, Velo Veneto may ask you to leave The Camp, with no right to a refund.
9. You agree that illegal drugs are not permitted at The Camp and possession of them may result in immediate termination of your participation in The Camp, with no right to a refund.
10. You release Velo Veneto and its employees and agents from all claims, demands, actions or causes of action for injuries, losses, liabilities or damages that you may have any time relating to or arising out of your attendance in The Camp, your participation in The Camp activities, and your travel to or from The Camp.
11. Velo Veneto reserves the right to take photographic or film records of any of its activities or participants and you agree that Velo Veneto may use any such records for promotional and/or commercial purposes, as well as approve such use by third parties with whom Velo Veneto may engage in joint marketing, without any remuneration to you.
12. I (the undersigned) have disclosed to Velo Veneto all relevant facts pertaining to my fitness and health.
13. If I am married, have executed this document on behalf of myself, my spouse, and the marital community.
14. This Agreement and Release is governed by the laws of the United States of America and the State of California.

Velo Veneto Release

I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT BY SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT, I AM ASSUMING RISKS, AND AGREEING TO INDEMNIFY, NOT TO SUE AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY THE ORGANIZER OF ANY VELO VENETO CYCLING CAMP (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE CAMP) AND ITS RESPECTIVE AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, MEMBERS, SPONSORS, PARTNERS, AND AFFILIATES (COLLECTIVELY "RELEASEES"), AND THAT I AM GIVING UP SUBSTANTIAL LEGAL RIGHTS. THIS RELEASE IS A CONTRACT WITH LEGAL AND BINDING CONSEQUENCES. I HAVE READ IT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING, AND I UNDERSTAND WHAT IT MEANS AND WHAT I AM AGREEING TO BY SIGNING.

In consideration of the acceptance of my application to The Camp, I hereby freely agree to and make the following contractual representations and agreements.

I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT CYCLING IS AN INHERENTLY DANGEROUS SPORT AND FULLY REALIZE THE DANGERS OF PARTICIPATING IN THE CAMP AND ASSOCIATED EVENTS, whether as a rider, spectator, or otherwise, and FULLY ASSUME THE RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH SUCH PARTICIPATION INCLUDING, by way of example, and not limitation: dangers associated with man-made and natural jumps; the dangers of collision with pedestrians, vehicles, other riders, and fixed or moving objects; the dangers arising from surface hazards, including potholes, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment, use of equipment or materials provided by the The Camp and others, THE RELEASEES' OWN NEGLIGENCE, the negligence of others and weather conditions; and the possibility of serious physical and/or mental trauma or injury, or death associated with The Camp.

For myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, assignees, and successors in interest (collectively "Successors") I HEREBY WAIVE, RELEASE, DISCHARGE, HOLD HARMLESS, AND PROMISE TO INDEMNIFY AND NOT TO SUE the Releasees and all sponsors, organizers and promoting organizations, property owners, law enforcement agencies, public entities, special districts and properties that are in any manner connected with The Camp and associated events, and their respective agents, officials, and employees through or by which the events will be held, (the foregoing are also collectively deemed to be Releasees), FROM ANY AND ALL RIGHTS AND CLAIMS INCLUDING CLAIMS ARISING FROM THE RELEASEES' OWN NEGLIGENCE, which I have or which may hereafter accrue to me, and from any and all damages which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly in connection with, or arising out of, my participation in or association with The Camp, or travel to or return from The Camp.

I agree it is my sole responsibility to be familiar with the courses and agenda, the Releasees' rules, and any special regulations for The Camp and agree to comply with all such rules and regulations. I understand and agree that situations may arise during The Camp which may be beyond the control of the Releasees, and I must continually ride and otherwise participate so as not to endanger myself or others.

I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my equipment, any equipment provided for my use, and my conduct in connection with The Camp. I will wear a helmet that satisfies the requirements of the Releasees' Rules or Regulations and that can protect against serious head injury, and assume all responsibility and liability for the selection of such a helmet.

I have no physical or medical condition that would endanger myself or others if I participate in The Camp, or would interfere with my ability to safely participate in The Camp.

I agree, for myself and my Successors, that the above representations are contractually binding, and are not mere recitals, and that should I or my Successors assert a claim contrary to what I have agreed to in this contract, the claiming party shall be liable for the expenses (including legal fees) incurred by the Releasees in defending the claims. This contract may not be modified orally, and a waiver or modification of any provision shall not be construed as a waiver or modification of any other provision herein or as a consent to any subsequent waiver or modification.

I consent to the release by any third party to Releasees and their insurance carriers of my name and medical information that may relate solely to any injury or death I may suffer arising from the event.

I ATTEST THAT I AM EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER [19 IN ALABAMA] (OR THAT IF I AM YOUNGER, MY PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIAN HAVE EXECUTED THIS WAIVER BELOW), AND THAT I AM PHYSICALLY FIT AND SUFFICIENTLY TRAINED TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CAMP OR EVENTS AND MY PARTICIPATION IN THE CAMP OR SUCH EVENTS IS VOLUNTARY.

Every term and provision of this contract is intended to be severable. If any one or more of them is found to be unenforceable or invalid, that shall not affect the other terms and provisions, which shall remain binding and enforceable.
